SABINA KIRRANE was born about 1827 Cloonygowan near Swineford, County Mayo in Ireland

1863 - Daniel Caffrey married Sabina Kirrane on the 12th of January 1863 in in the Roman Catholic Church of Killasser about one mile North of Swineford, County Mayo in Ireland

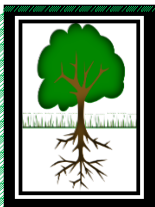
They had seven children, one of whom was:

PATRICK WILLIAM CAFFREY was born on Friday the 1st of February 1867 in Cloonagom near Swineford, County Mayo in Ireland to Daniel Caffrey and Sabina Kirrane Patrick became generally known as "William"

1891 – Census – England RG12/3619

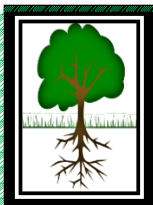

Edwin aged 23 working as a Stuff Warehouse Man

Selemna (sic) aged 21 working as a Stuff Weaver

Jessie aged 16 working as a Stuff Weaver

George aged 14 working as a Stuff Spinner

William aged 12 working as a Stuff Spinner

All the children were born in Bradford, Yorkshire

1892 – Patrick William Caffrey married Janet McIntyre on the 4th August 1892 at the Registrar Office in Bradford, Yorkshire in England

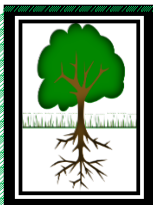

All the children and grandchildren were born in Bradford, Yorkshire

They are living in 398, Manchester Road. Horton in Bradford, West Riding in Yorkshire

This shows William P Caffrey aged 43 working as a General Labourer (Gas Works) and born in Swineford, Co Mayo in Ireland and Janet aged 36 working as a Fruiterer with their children; Florence aged 18 working as a Cheese Winder born in Bradford in Yorkshire and her sister Silema aged 16 working as a Fruiter's Assistant

They are all staying with Janet's sister Annie Elizabeth McIntyre aged 55, Single and has a Fruiterer business

Also there is her brother Edwin aged 53 and Single working as a Stuff and Woollen Warehouse Man

They were all born in Bradford, Yorkshire apart from William Caffrey and are all residing at 306 Manchester Road Bradford

1943 – William died aged 75 on 7 January 1943 in Manchester, Lancashire in England but was buried in Bradford, Yorkshire in England
